INTERIM

Interim is an external/non-traditional learning experience for our students. Now in its nineteenth year, Interim is designed to give students the opportunity to learn about things not traditionally taught during the regular school day. It is also an opportunity for many students to actually leave the school and have an educational experience at a site that pertains to their particular program.

Interim is a four-day program, which will run from Tuesday, June 3, 2014 thru Friday, June 6, 2014. During this time, students must do the following:

- Participate in a variety of learning activities
- Show evidence of learning through projects, journals, presentations, reports or tests as determined by the instructor
- Have good attendance. Participation in Interim is mandatory and is a graduation requirement.

The Interim programs have been placed into three categories. **Students are required to take an interim their Freshman, Sophomore and Junior year, as this is a regular school week where attendance will be accountable.** The categories are:

- 1) Life Skills
- 2) Academic
- 3) Career

Please work with your student in selecting an Interim program along with alternatives in case the initial choice has been closed due to enrollment. Some Interim programs require the student to pay certain fees. Please discuss this matter with your student prior to selecting a particular Interim program. **Juniors will have first choice of an interim program if their form is turned in by Friday, September 13th , then we go on a first come first serve basis.** The registration form will be dated when the student turns them in to the main office.

If you are a spring athlete, stop in the Athletic Office to review a tentative sports schedule as spring sports may conflict with Interim.

If you do select a travel interim and need to transfer out, you will lose your initial deposit unless you can find someone to take your spot.

Interim registration forms need to be turned in to the High School main office no later than Friday, September 20th.

If your child has any health issues that need special attention then one parent will be required to attend the interim at the same cost.

- Description Students will experience and learn about Italian culture and Roman history by traveling through Italy over the course of 9 days. This trip will take students from Milan and Venice through Florence and Assisi to Rome and the Vatican. Students will see firsthand the art and architecture that has made Italy famous for centuries. Students will tour the Grand Canal in Venice, see Michelangelo's "David" in Florence, and visit the Basilica of St. Frances in Assisi. Students will also tour the papal museums and the Basilica of St. Peter in the Vatican, and the Coliseum and the Forum in Rome. Students will have guided English tours in every place that we visit as well as free time to explore.

The cost of the trip includes airfare, hotel accommodations, breakfast and dinner daily, a full time English-speaking tour director, daily English speaking local guides, and admission to all attractions. Students will be responsible for purchasing their own lunch each day and souvenirs.

A passport is required for this interim.

- Description One adventure will be at Historic Mill Creek Discovery Park which involves a nature tour that includes 3 elements plus tour the saw mill. One night will be spent on Mackinac Island and an entire day will be devoted to experiencing the island through activities such as biking around the base of the island, a tour of Fort Mackinac, a hike with an islander, and a private haunted history tour. Then overnight accommodations for 2 nights will be at a hotel in Munising in the Upper Peninsula. One of the adventures will be to experience a 1.5 hr. Riptide Ride on a Navy Seal vessel along the Grand Island, viewing 25 miles of the tallest cliffs, admiring Bald Eagles, waterfalls, looking at the highest lighthouse above sea level, and in between the sights with a narration of the area's vast history, the ride will include 360^o spins, turns, and amazing speed. Another extraordinary adventure will be a 2 hr. live narrated tour aboard the glass bottom boat of the Miss Munising or Fireball which features the best underwater views of 3 shipwrecks in the Munising Bay, a prehistoric underwater forest, and sights above the water such as the East Channel Lighthouse and rock formations found nowhere else in the world. The last adventure will be to stop in Mackinaw City on the way home to climb the Old Mackinac Point Lighthouse.
