

PRIDE IN PINK

Pink Arrow Pride is an annual fundraiser held by Lowell students and residents. Football players wear pink jerseys bearing the names of loved ones with cancer. The day-long event on Friday, Sept. 6, also featured soccer and volleyball matches. Funds are raised by the sale of pink T-shirts and corporate sponsorships.

Proceeds go to four areas:

- The Lowell Community Wellness Organization, to assist families dealing with cancer in everything from medical expenses to utilities
- Gilda's Club of Lowell, which holds dinners and support sessions on Tuesday evenings
- The Kathy Talus Memorial Scholarship, a fund for female college athletes named after a teacher and coach who died of breast cancer
- Scholarships in honor of Dr. Donald Gerard, given to Lowell graduates attending medical school
